Matthew 8

5 When He had entered Capernaum, a centurion came forward to Him, appealing to Him, 6 "Lord, my servant is lying paralyzed at home, suffering terribly." 7 And He said to him, "I will come and heal him." 8 But the centurion replied, "Lord, I am not worthy to have you come under my roof, but only say the word, and my servant will be healed. 9 For I too am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. And I say to one, 'Go,' and he goes, and to another, 'Come,' and he comes, and to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." 10 When Jesus heard this, He marveled and said to those who followed Him, "Truly, I tell you, with no one in Israel have I found such faith.

Authority – 1. the power of authority (influence) and of right (privilege); 2. the power of rule or government (the power of him whose will and commands must be submitted to by others and obeyed)

Gleanings from the Centurion 1) Seeking Authority

Luke 7

2 Now a centurion had a servant who was sick and at the point of death, who was highly valued by him. 3 When the centurion heard about Jesus

The centurion sought Jesus out and came to Him. On a strictly human level, it would be perfectly within the rights of the centurion to issue the order that Jesus be found, and be commanded to come to him. Jesus was, after all, a citizen of Roman-occupied territory. But the Roman commander doesn't find Jesus and order that He be brought to him. Instead, the centurion seeks Jesus out in order to come to Him... **Greg Allen Commentary**
